Highlights from Bioindustrial Innovation Canada's nomination

BIC is committed to the integration of green and sustainable chemistry with traditional petroleum industries and sourcing strictly natural, local, and sustainable resources.

BIC established the Bowman Centre accelerator, North America's first bioindustrial laboratories and shared pilot plant facility for gasification, pyrolysis, fermentation and bio-conversion. The accelerator houses innovative companies like Woodland Biofuels, GreenCore Composites and KmX Corporation and hosts visitors from around the world.

BIC is partnering closely with Lambton College's new BioIndustrial Process Research Centre and has helped attract BioAmber to build the world's largest bio-succinic acid production plant in Sarnia-Lambton.
