Emera was created out of the privatization of the provincial crown corporation Nova Scotia Power Inc; it is an energy and services company based in Halifax, Nova Scotia. The company invests in electricity generation, transmission and distribution, and gas transmission and utility energy services. Emera companies are working to create cleaner energy and deliver it to market. They maintain high standards in safety, reliability, customer service and environmental care.

Reason for nomination:

Emera has grown substantially over the past two decades to become a diversified international energy company based in Halifax. It is a leader in building renewable energy capacity and creating a more integrated energy grid through the Maritime Link project.

They have made substantial investments in wind, biomass, hydro, solar and have a strategic focus on the future potential of tidal energy. These investments have helped improve the environmental performance of Nova Scotia's traditionally coal-based electricity system.
