Bear Head LNG Nova Scotia

Bear Head LNG is wholly owned by Liquefied Natural Gas Limited. Bear Head LNG proposes to develop an 8 mtpa liquefied natural gas export facility on the Strait of Canso, Nova Scotia, Canada, with targeted first LNG in 2019 / 2020.

Highlights from Bear Head's nomination

Bear Head LNG is the first proposed Canadian LNG export facility to be recognized by the U.S. Federal Energy Regulatory Commission as an "Approved" Canadian LNG export project.

Furthermore, Bear Head LNG understands the need to create solid relationships in support of project development. As a result, our team maintains regular contact with provincial government officials, political leaders and industry partners in the capital of Halifax, and with community, political and business leaders in the Strait of Canso area.

Bear Head LNG has also carefully followed the First Nations consultation process. As a result, a memorandum of understanding has been signed by the Assembly of Nova Scotia Mi'kmaq Chiefs and Bear Head LNG.
