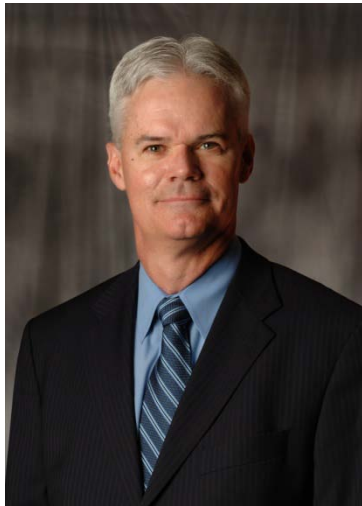


## Pat Horgan
